

Book of Acts: Verses about Receiving the Holy Spirit

Acts 2

38 "Repent," Peter said to them, "and be baptized, each of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will **receive the gift** of the Holy Spirit.

Acts 8

14 When the apostles who were at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had welcomed God's message, they sent Peter and John to them. 15 After they went down there, they prayed for them, so the Samaritans might **receive the Holy Spirit**. 16 For He had not yet come down on any of them; they had only been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. 17 Then Peter and John laid their hands on them, and they **received the Holy Spirit**. 18 When Simon saw that the Holy Spirit was given through the laying on of the apostles' hands, he offered them money, 19 saying, "Give me this power too, so that anyone I lay hands on may receive the Holy Spirit." 20 But Peter told him, "May your silver be destroyed with you, because you thought the **gift of God** could be obtained with money!

Acts 10

45 The circumcised believers who had come with Peter were astounded because the **gift of the Holy Spirit** had been poured out on the Gentiles also.

Acts 1

8 But you will receive **power** when the **Holy Spirit has come on you**, and you will be My witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.

Acts 10

44 While Peter was still speaking these words, the **Holy Spirit came down on** all those who heard the message. 45 The circumcised believers who had come with Peter were astounded because the gift of the Holy Spirit had been **poured out** on the Gentiles also. 46 For they heard them speaking in other languages and declaring the greatness of God. Then Peter responded, 47 "Can anyone withhold water and prevent these people from being baptized, who have **received the Holy Spirit just as we have?**" 48 And he commanded them to be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ. Then they asked him to stay for a few days.

Acts 8

14 When the apostles who were at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had welcomed God's message, they sent Peter and John to them. 15 After they went down there, they prayed for them, so the Samaritans might **receive the Holy Spirit**. 16 For He had **not yet**

Acts 11

15 “As I began to speak, the **Holy Spirit came down** on them, just as on us at the beginning.

Acts 19

6 And when Paul had laid his hands on them, the **Holy Spirit came on them**, and they began to speak in other languages and to prophesy.

Acts 2

17 And it will be in the last days, says God, that I will **pour out My Spirit** on all humanity; then your sons and your daughters will prophesy, your young men will see visions, and your old men will dream dreams. 18 I will even **pour out My Spirit** on My male and female slaves in those days, and they will prophesy.

Acts 1

4 While He was together with them, He commanded them not to leave Jerusalem, but to **wait for the Father’s promise.** “This,” He said, “is what you heard from Me; 5 for John baptized with water, but you will be **baptized with the Holy Spirit** not many days from now.”

Acts 11

16 Then I remembered the word of the Lord, how He said, ‘John baptized with water, but you will be **baptized with the Holy Spirit.**’ 17 Therefore, if God gave them the same gift that He also gave to us when we believed on the Lord Jesus Christ, how could I possibly hinder God?”

Acts 2

4 Then they were all **filled with the Holy Spirit** and began to speak in different languages, as the Spirit gave them ability for speech.

Acts 9

17 So Ananias left and entered the house. Then he placed his hands on him and said, “Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus, who appeared to you on the road you were traveling, has sent me so that you can regain your sight and be **filled with the Holy Spirit.**”

Acts 1

8 But you will receive **power** when the Holy Spirit has come on you, and you will be My **witnesses** in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.

Acts 2

4 Then they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to **speak in different languages**, as the Spirit gave them ability for speech... 11 **...we hear them speaking the magnificent acts of God in our own languages.**

Acts 10

46 For they heard them **speaking in other languages** and **declaring the greatness of God.**

Acts 8

18 When **Simon saw that the Holy Spirit was given** through the laying on of the apostles' hands, he offered them money, 19 saying, "Give me this power too, so that anyone I lay hands on may receive the Holy Spirit."

Acts 10

46 For they heard them **speaking in other languages** and **declaring the greatness of God...**

Acts 19

6 And when Paul had laid his hands on them, the Holy Spirit came on them, and they began to **speak in other languages** and to **prophecy.**

Acts 9

17 So Ananias left and entered the house. Then he placed his hands on him and said, "Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus, who appeared to you on the road you were traveling, has sent me so that you can regain your sight and be filled with the Holy Spirit." 18 At once **something like scales fell from his eyes**, and he **regained his sight**. Then he got up and was baptized... 22 But Saul **grew more capable and kept confounding** the Jews who lived in Damascus by proving that this One is the Messiah.

Acts 2:14-36 - Peter's bold sermon

Acts 5

29 But Peter and the apostles replied, "We must obey God rather than men. 30 The God of our fathers raised up Jesus, whom you had murdered by hanging Him on a tree.

31 God exalted this man to His right hand as ruler and Savior, to grant repentance to Israel, and forgiveness of sins. 32 We are witnesses of these things, and so is the Holy Spirit whom God has given **to those who obey Him.**”

Acts 6

8 Stephen, full of grace and power, was performing **great wonders and signs** among the people.

Acts 13

9 Then Saul—also called **Paul**—**filled with the Holy Spirit, stared straight at the sorcerer** 10 and said, “You son of the Devil, full of all deceit and all fraud, enemy of all righteousness! Won’t you ever stop perverting the straight paths of the Lord? 11 Now, look! The Lord’s hand is against you. **You are going to be blind**, and will not see the sun for a time.” **Suddenly a mist and darkness fell on him**, and he went around seeking someone to lead him by the hand. 12 Then the **proconsul, seeing what happened, believed** and was astonished at the teaching about the Lord.

Heb 2

4 At the same time, God also testified by **signs and wonders, various miracles**, and distributions of gifts from the Holy Spirit according to His will.

Gal 3

5 So then, does God supply you with the **Spirit and work miracles** among you by the works of the law or by hearing with faith?

Acts 6

8 Stephen, full of grace and power, was **performing great wonders and signs** among the people.

Eph 1

13 When you heard the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and **when you believed in Him**, you were also **sealed with the promised Holy Spirit**. 14 He is the **down payment** of our inheritance, for the redemption of the possession, to the praise of His glory.

Eph 5

18 And don’t get drunk with wine, which leads to reckless actions, but be **filled by the Spirit**: 19 **speaking to one another** in psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs, singing and making music from your heart **to the Lord**, 20 **giving thanks always for everything** to

God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, 21 **submitting to one another in the fear of Christ.**

Gal 5

16 I say then, **walk by the Spirit** and you will not carry out the desire of the flesh. 17 For the flesh desires what is against the Spirit, and the Spirit desires what is against the flesh; these are opposed to each other, so that you don't do what you want. 18 But if you are **led by the Spirit**, you are not under the law. 19 Now the works of the flesh are obvious: sexual immorality, moral impurity, promiscuity, 20 idolatry, sorcery, hatreds, strife, jealousy, outbursts of anger, selfish ambitions, dissensions, factions, 21 envy, drunkenness, carousing, and anything similar. I tell you about these things in advance—as I told you before—that **those who practice** such things will not inherit the kingdom of God. 22 **But the fruit of the Spirit** is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faith, 23 gentleness, self-control. Against such things there is no law. 24 Now those who belong to Christ Jesus have **crucified the flesh** with its passions and desires. 25 Since **we live by the Spirit**, we must **also follow the Spirit**. 26 We must **not become conceited, provoking one another, envying one another.**

John 14

11 **Believe Me** that I am in the Father and the Father is in Me. **Otherwise, believe because of the works themselves.** 12 "I assure you: **The one who believes in Me will also do the works that I do.** And he **will do even greater works** than these, because I am going to the Father. 13 Whatever you ask in My name, I will do it so that the Father may be glorified in the Son. 14 If you ask Me anything in My name, I will do it.
